- Site requirements for the welfare of construction workers on site
- The key issues and control of site activities, for example:
 - plans and risk assessment
 - roofs and fragile surfaces
 - working platforms and ladders
 - management use and stability of scaffolds
 - fall arrest and suspension equipment
